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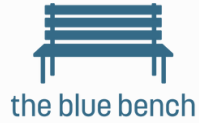

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38% of women
& **7%** of men

have reported experiencing sexual harassment at work.



1 in 7 women
& **1 in 17 men**

have sought a new job assignment, changed jobs, or quit a job because of sexual harassment and assault.



Employees who experience sexual harassment are more likely to report

PTSD, depression, stress, and anxiety.



Your commitment

The SHIELD program offers:

- In-house workplace harassment training
- An audit of current workplace harassment policies within the establishment
- C Suite/leadership specific training
- A “Blue Bench Certified: Safe Workplace” stamp of approval that you can advertise to the public, internally, and to prospective employees

Cost structure:

- \$30 per employee
 - *Minimum of \$500, capped at \$5K*

Redistribution model:

- A portion of funds raised from SHIELD trainings will be redistributed to cover trainings provided to low-income schools, 501-c3 non-profits, or small/struggling businesses
